Hugh made his debut for La Boite Theatre Company in the 2011 season production of *Julius Caesar*. He will also be performing in Queensland Theatre Company & Black Swan State Theatres 2011 seasons *Cat on a Hot Tin Roof*. In Queensland Theatre Company's 2010 season he performed in *Betrayal* (for which he received an Actor in a Leading Role Matilda nomination) and *The Clean House*, in their 2009 season *25 Down*. The Black Swan State Theatre Company in Perth also showcased *The Clean House*. Hughs other theatre credits included *The Thirty Nine Steps* (The Byre Theatre, St Andrews UK), *Cream of British Comedy* (Teenage Cancer Charity Trust / Steve Coogan UK) and *A Midsummer Nights Dream* (The Royal Shakespeare Company UK).
